■ システム情報科学府のアドミッションポリシー ■

計算機や情報処理技術の高度化と普及によって、情報科学は数学や物理学などに匹敵する科学方法論の基礎を与える基礎科学として、極めて重要な学問分野となりつつある。また、情報科学のもたらす成果は一般社会生活へも深く浸透し、工業分野全般への情報処理技術の適用はもちろんのこと、社会・文化・経済にも大きな影響を与えている。一方、長い歴史と大きな産業分野を抱える電気電子工学は、情報産業の母体として常にその発展に寄与しただけでなく、極めて高機能化・複雑化・大規模化した電気電子システムを生み出してきたが、今後も情報科学と密接な連携のもとに発展して行くことが期待される。そのような社会からの要望に応えるため、システム情報科学府は総合的で広い視野を持ち、かつそれぞれの分野で深い専門的知識と研究開発能力を備えた次世代の研究者や技術者を育成することを目指している。この趣旨に合った意欲ある学生を受け入れる。

■ Admission Policy ■

Owing to the advancement and spread of computers and information processing technology, information science has become an important academic discipline that provides a fundamental scientific methodology comparable to mathematics and physics. Moreover, progress in information science has permeated various aspects of our daily life and has been influential not only to industries in general, but also to our society, culture, and economy. On the other front, electrical and electronic engineering has a long and distinguished history in supporting extensive industrial fields. It has continuously contributed as a matrix of information industry and produced extremely sophisticated, complicated, and large-in-scale electrical and electronic systems. Electrical and electronic engineering is expected to further develop in close cooperation with information science. To respond to such social demands, the Graduate School of Information Science and Electrical Engineering aims to educate next generation researchers and engineers with comprehensive, broad vision, in-depth expertise and research and development capability in each specialized field. We admit students with a strong will to learn in order to meet such requirements.

1. Application qualification

- (1) Applicants who have graduated from universities or colleges or candidates for graduation from universities or colleges set forth in Article 83 of the School Education Act by March 31, 2018.
- (2) Applicants who have bachelor's degrees awarded pursuant to the regulations of section 4, Article 104 of the School Education Act (Applicants with bachelor's degrees awarded by the National Institution for Academic Degrees and Quality Enhancement of Higher Education) or candidates to be awarded bachelor's degrees by March 31, 2018.
- (3) Applicants who have completed 16 years of formal education in their home countries or are expected to complete their education by March 31, 2018.
- (4) Applicants who have completed 16 years of formal education in their home countries by supplementing a foreign correspondence course offered in Japan or are expected to complete the aforementioned by March 31, 2018.
- (5) Applicants who have bachelor's degrees from foreign educational institutions positioned as facilities that have curricula equivalent to a university in Japan (such holders of bachelor's degrees should have completed 16 years of formal education in such foreign countries) by the school system of such foreign countries as specified by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports and Science and Technology or are expected to graduate with a bachelor's degree from the same institution by March 31, 2018.
- (6) Applicants who have a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree by completing the course with the period for completion of more than three years at a foreign university or foreign school (as evaluated by the foreign government or accreditation organization of such a foreign country or specified as equivalent to such educational institutions by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports and Science and Technology). (This may include applicants who have completed the course equivalent to the same course in Japan through a correspondence course provided by a foreign educational institution or at a foreign educational institution positioned as a facility that has a university curricula specified as equivalent to an educational institution in Japan as prescribed in the preceding item.)
- (7) Applicants who have completed specialist courses of technical colleges (limited to the course with the period for more than four years and one that can satisfy all the requirements set by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports and Science and Technology) after the date designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports and Science and Technology or who are expected to compete the same course by March 31, 2018.
- (8) Applicants who are designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports and Science and Technology.
- (9) Applicants who are recognized for their academic ability as deemed appropriate for education to be provided by our institution in accordance with the provision of section 2, Article 102 of the School Education Act.
- (10) Applicants who are recognized for their academic ability equivalent to those who graduated from university by means of an entrance qualification screening conducted by our institution and are expected to reach the age of twenty-two prior to enrollment in our school.
- (11) Applicants who completed 15 years of formal education in foreign countries and recognized as having acquired all predetermined credits with excellent results at our institution.
- (12) Applicants who completed 15 years of formal education in their home countries by supplementing foreign correspondence courses offered in Japan and recognized as having acquired all predetermined

credits with excellent results at our institution.

(13) Applicants who have bachelor's degree from foreign educational institutions positioned as facilities that have a university curricula (such holder of a bachelor's degree should have completed 15 years of formal education in such foreign countries) by a school system in such foreign countries and are specified by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports and Science and Technology and recognized as having acquired all predetermined credits with excellent results at our institution.

(Reminders for filing an application)

If you are employees of government agencies or companies and wish to enroll and have the qualifications certified under the above (2) or (9)-(13), please consult the Student Affairs Section, Student Affairs Division, School of Engineering, Kyushu University prior to submission of an application.

*Applicants who file applications in accordance with the above (9)-(13) shall undergo the preliminary screening process for application qualification.

3. Entrance examination

Our entrance examination consists of two categories: general examination and special examination.

- General examination

The general examination consists of the written examination and the oral examination. The general examination is carried out for those applicants who are not entitled to or have not chosen the special examination.

- Special examination

As a part of the special examination, the viva voce examination will be conducted first, which will recognize and pass the applicants with strong will to learn and high adequacy in the department applied for, as well as adequate academic ability, before setting the written examination or the oral examination. Applicants can take the viva voce examination only for the department or the course of their first choice. However, applicants who wish to take the viva voce examination may list their second choice on the application form. Your application for the second choice will be examined only if you fail the viva voce examination. In this case, you are required to take the written examination and the oral examination. Applicants who wish to take the special examination will be screened for eligibility for the viva voce examination based on an examination of the documents, such as academic transcripts issued by the final school attended. The result of this examination will be reported in writing along with an examination admission slip to be sent to an applicant who wishes to take the special examination (scheduled to be sent around June 2, 2017). Those not selected for the viva voce examination or who failed the viva voce examination should take the written examination and the oral examination.

(Notes)

- (1) The special examination is carried out only for applicants who wish to enroll the Department of Informatics or the Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering.
- (2) Applicants who are entitled to the special examination are those who are expected to graduate from a university other than Kyushu University or complete an advanced course of a technical college.

6. English Proficiency Test (TOEIC, TOEFL)

(1) Applicants are required to take any of the TOEIC official test, TOEFL-iBT, TOEFL-CBT, or TOEFL-P BT prior to filing an application.

- Score certificates mean the Official Score Certificate from TOEIC or Test Taker Score Report and Examinee Score Report from TOEFL issued by the test administrator and sent directly to the applicant by them. The Official Score Certificate should accompany a face photo of an applicant and only effective if the specified test date is within two years before the scheduled date of the written examination (August 17, 2017).
- The following scores cannot be accepted.
Scores obtained from the Group Application Program such as TOEIC IP, college TOEIC, or TOEFL ITP.

(2) Fill out the official score in the appropriate area of your application form and submit a copy of the Official Score Certificate from the TOEIC or TOEFL for application.

- If you have not received the Official Score Certificate during the application period, although you have taken the TOEIC or TOEFL test, you may specify the test date on your application form and then submit a copy as soon as the Certificate arrives.

(3) For an original copy of the Official Score Certificate required on the actual examination day, you shall follow the guidance specified below.

● Applicants who take the viva voce examination for the Department of Informatics.

- Bring an original copy of the Official Score Certificate on the day of the oral examination. You are also allowed to bring an original copy of the latest score renewed after the application.
- The viva voce examination will be assessed on the basis of the Official Score Certificate (original) to be brought on the day of the examination.
- If the Official Score Certificate (original) is not presented on the day of the viva voce examination, the applicant will be deemed to have failed the examination.

● Applicants who take the viva voce examination of the Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering

- Not necessary to bring the original copy of the Official Score Certificate on the day of the examination.

● Applicants who take the written examination

- Bring the original copy of the Official Score Certificate on the day of examination. You are also allowed to bring the original copy of the latest score renewed after the application or viva voce examination.
- Final assessment shall be made only on the basis of the Official Score Certificate (original) to be brought on the day of the examination.
- If the Official Score Certificate (original) is not presented on the day of examination, the English score becomes zero.

7. Entrance examination fee

Entrance examination fee 30,000 yen.

There are three payment methods. You may choose one to pay the entrance examination fee. Upon completion of payment, attach (1) a copy of a remittance receipt, (2) a copy of the screen with notification of payment completion, or (3) a certificate of the payment (as explained in “Entrance Examination Fee/Screening Fee/Detailed Statement”) to the designated field of the “Entrance examination fee sheet”, state the name of the graduate school you are applying to, your address, name, and telephone number, and submit it as an application document. Please note that payment period starts on May 8 (Mon.), 2017, you must make sure that the certificate of payment is submitted during the application period.

Applicants are liable for relevant bank fees.

8. Preliminary screening for application eligibility

For the purpose of preliminary screening for the application eligibility, applicants who apply pursuant to application qualification (9)-(13) shall submit application documents (1)-(4), (6), (7), (9), and (11) to the Student Affairs Section, Student Affairs Division of the School of Engineering during the period from June

19, 2017 (Mon.) to 12 p.m., June 23, 2017 (Fri.). The results will be reported to the applicants by the head of the department by June 27 (Tue.). For those who passed the qualification screening, their application documents will be automatically accepted after receipt of the counterfoil of entrance examination fee.

16. Long-term program

The Graduate School of Information Science and Electrical Engineering also offers a program to students with occupations and handicaps who want to complete the course in a planned manner, which allows them to complete their course exceeding the normal period of the curriculum. If they apply for this program and such an application is admitted, their annual tuition fee will be the amount of the normal tuition fee divided by the number of years required for completing the course. More information on required procedures will be reported at enrollment registration.

- (1) Applicants who wish to have application materials (application form) sent to a mailing address must ask the Student Affairs Section, Student Affairs Division, School of Engineering, by sending an envelope noting “Application Document for the Master’s Program of the Graduate School of Information Science and Electrical Engineering” in red ink; the envelope should enclose a return envelope (Squire No. 2) noting your name, the postal code and address with a 205-yen stamp attached.
- (2) Once an application is received, no revisions to the written contents are allowed, and the entrance examination fee will not be refunded.
- (3) If your examination admission slip has not arrived, please report to the Student Affairs Section, Student Affairs Division, Graduate School of Engineering, before the examination day.

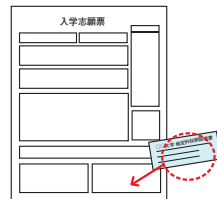

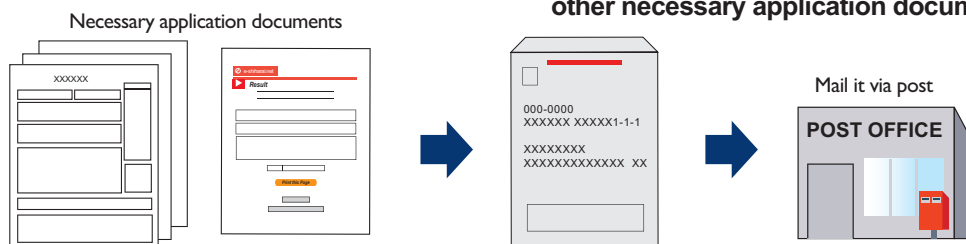
